GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION INFORMATION

All garbage cans, recycling cans, bags, and bulk items must be visible to the driver and placed at the curb **no later than 5:00 am, the day of your scheduled collection day.** Any trash or recycling set out after 5:00 am on scheduled collection day will be noted and may not be picked up.

NO LOOSE GARBAGE

All refuse must be bagged and placed in cans or bagged in heavy plastic. Bags must be securely tied and weigh no more than 40lbs and be able to be lifted by one person.

UNACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS

DO NOT PLACE GARBAGE IN GROCERY BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES OR 55 GALLON DRUMS.

LARGE ITEMS

One large item a week is permitted for each customer.

HOLIDAYS

There will be a one-day delay for the following holidays:

Thanksgiving Day

Christmas Day

Independence Day

New Year's Day Labor Day

YARD WASTE

Shrubbery and tree trimmings must not be more than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than 3 feet in length. All trimmings and shrubbery must be secured tightly to enable lifting by one person.

CHRISTMAS TREES COLLECTION

Pick up of trees will take place from January 1st through January 15th. All decorations, tinsel, etc., must be removed. Any Christmas tree taller than 6 feet must be cut in half to be collected.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL

Construction material is not included in the cost of service. For small amounts of construction material, please call the Township Administrative Office for special pricing and to schedule pick up.

COLLECTIBLE MATERIALS

1. Bulky Materials - One Large Item Per Week from Each Residence

- a. Furniture (chairs, couches, mattress and box springs, and other household items generated from the customers address only) stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers.
- b. Hot water tanks and toilets must have the liquids removed.
- c. Small appliances such as but not limited to microwaves, small kitchen appliances, carpet sweepers etc., are accepted.

2. Carpeting

a. carpet, rugs and padding must be **CUT AND SECURED** into 4ft by 12 inches in diameter. No more than 6 rolls may be placed at the curb each week.

3. Needles and Sharp Objects

- a. All needles, syringes, and lancets must be placed in a plastic container with a secure lid and then placed in the container into your garbage.
- b. All other sharp items including glass and metal must be placed in a cardboard box or wrapped with heavy paper and tape closed before placing in your garbage.

4. Paint

- a. No liquid paint may be placed in the garbage for collection unless cat litter or paint hardener is placed into the paint to solidify.
- b. All paint cans must be placed at the curb with the lid off so that employees may see that the paint is no longer in liquid form.

5. Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers & Water Coolers

a. Freon must be removed by certified technician and appropriate sticker indicating freon has been removed must be visible. *Please remove all doors for safety.*

RECYCLING - ALL RECYCLABLES MUST BE LOOSE IN THE RECYCLING CAN.

Recycling will be collected every other week.

COLLECTIBLE RECYCLING MATERIALS

- 1. Plastic Bottles & containers: #1-5 & 7
- 2. **Metal cans:** Steel, tin & aluminum soda, vegetable, fruit & tuna cans.
- 3. **Paper:** Brown paper bags, office paper, newspaper, magazines. Paper cardboard, dairy & juice containers. Flattened cardboard & paper board. (Corrugated cardboard, construction paper, kraft paper, cereal boxes, shoeboxes etc.)

NON-COLLECTIBLE MATERIALS

- 1. Food Waste, Plastic Bags, or Polystyrene Foam Cups & Containers.
- 2. No Glass Will Be Accepted Properly Place All Glass in With Solid Waste
